



A4421 BUCKINGHAM ROAD (BICESTER) PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to construct the following feature within northern Bicester. The proposals seek to help improve pedestrian and pedal cyclist safety in respect to the new Bicester Heritage housing development:

A **Toucan crossing** (signal-controlled crossing for use by both pedestrians and pedal cyclists) at the following location:

- A4421 Buckingham Road – approx. 25* metres southwest of its junction with Skimmingdish Lane.

* All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the feature.
